

## **What grades or school conduct standards must players maintain**

Players must remain in **good academic standing** at their school. This means passing all classes, completing assignments, and demonstrating responsibility in the classroom. If a player is failing or consistently struggling academically, the Program Director and coach may reduce playing time, require improvement plans, or suspend participation until grades improve.

## **Are players expected to follow school behavior rules**

Yes. Players must show positive behavior at school, respect teachers and staff, follow all school rules, and maintain good attendance. Serious or repeated conduct issues may result in reduced playing time, suspension from team activities, or removal from the program.

## **Why does the program enforce academic and conduct standards**

As the official feeder program for Campbell High School, we prepare athletes for the expectations of high-school basketball, where academic eligibility and conduct are strictly enforced. We teach players that discipline in the classroom translates to discipline on the court.
